Filing for Patents

Patents are granted for any invention that is new, involves an inventive step and has industrial application. A utility innovation offers protection for anything deemed a 'minor' invention.

Applications may be made by the inventor or applicant, with appropriate evidence to support claim to the invention if not filed by the inventor.

Applicants wishing to apply for patents internationally must file in Malaysia first and can then apply for patents in other countries once two months has elapsed from the date of filing, assuming they are not notified of any prohibition to do so by the Malaysian Patent Office. A foreign filing license must be obtained from the Patent Office in order to apply internationally before this two month period has elapsed.

Under the *Patent Cooperation Treaty*, international patents designating Malaysia have the effect in Malaysia of national applications, provided that the necessary documentation is filed with the Malaysian Patent Office within 30 months of the international filing date.

Applications are examined as to form, inventive step, patentability and novelty. Every application is subject to a preliminary examination even if no request for formal examination is made.

Corrections can be submitted as follows: within three months of initial application; within three months of preliminary examination; and within two months of the substantive examination stage.

The application is laid open to public inspection 18 months from the filing date, or from the earliest priority date. If the invention is found to be patent-worthy after examination, it will be accepted for grant. The patent will be published in the Gazette.

Opposition may be taken up by appeal to the High Court (Intellectual Property).
